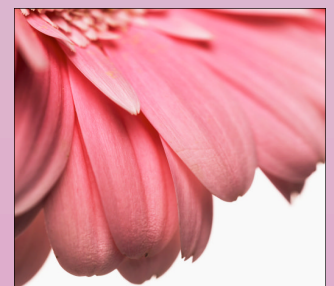

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## The Testimony of Dustin Query

(Part 4 of a Series)

I had to decide to play this game even farther until I got my own way. Running away every day seemed to be the answer to my problems. I would ride the bus to school, take off and walk the streets all day, and call some family member to come get me when it got dark. This went on for about a month and it didn't seem to get my grandma and pap's attention. That's all I wanted was to go back there. When that didn't seem to work I decided to go a different route. Sitting at home, desperate not to go to school the next day, I decided to cut my arm all up and smear blood all over the wall. When everybody got home an ambulance was called and I was once again admitted to the psychiatric ward. It was during this point that my problems seemed to really surface and I had made the decision that I wasn't going to go home. So they awarded custody to children and youth and I would soon be placed in a group home.

In the group home, I met a group of kids that I finally had something in common with. Their lives were just as messed up as mine. During the stay, I acted out a lot and frequent visits to what they called the "quiet room" were normal. One particular trip to the quiet room I will remember for the rest of my life. I was heavily medicated and one of the staff just seem to have enough of my crap and sent me to my humble abode with padded walls. The rest of the kids flipped out and I remember thinking that is what real friends were all about. All my life I just wanted acceptance. The one place I did get it, (church) I rejected because it wasn't what the world accepted.

The group home didn't last long I was heavily medicated and I tried to kill myself there a couple times. If I remember correctly, I think it was fourteen pills total that I had to take daily (give or take a few). I walked around like a zombie. It wasn't until I made it to another psychiatric ward that I finally came down off of cloud nine. It was a tough transition, but I seemed to cope by meeting a couple kids at this new place I was at. One of these kids was a guy named Leland. I looked up to him because he seemed to have the world figured out. Even though he was in a psychiatric ward with me, he seemed to have few cares in the world and he always seemed so content and "cool." Leland did a lot of drugs and his advice to me after hearing all my problems one day was, "Life is a ----- than you die. Forget the world—let's get high." So for the first time, at age 13, I tried morphine. My life had made a turn for the worse because, for the first time in my life, I felt no pain and I actually could feel good about myself.

After making it out of "nut ward," I began to find ways to get high whenever I could to block out all the pain. Leland had given me a ton of advice on how to get high around the house, such as huffing air freshener, drinking cough syrup, and stealing Rosie's pills. My life had made a definite turn for the worse. Stealing Rosie's pills became an every-other-day occurrence and I grew an addiction to oxycodone. I would take like 10 or 15 a day and I was hooking all my class mates up so they could get high, too. This brought me a new-found respect in a school where they hated me just a year prior.

## Look What the Lord Has Done!

I am taking this opportunity to update you on my son, Paul. One year ago, March 26th, 2008, he was discharged from the Harborview Hospital in Seattle Washington after spending 6 weeks in a coma and one month in rehab. He was beaten in the head, with a baseball bat, randomly, on a sunny afternoon, and left for dead. He had seven skull fractures and a brain bleed over his brain stem.

As I boarded a plane to Seattle, an ER doc told me he had a pulse and a blood pressure. He was going into surgery to stop the brain bleed.

Six weeks of sitting at his bedside, watching the vitals monitors. Unlike what I had previously thought - to hold the coma patients hand and talk to him, we had to not touch him and to keep our voices low. Any kind of disturbance to him, made his heart race and his blood pressure go up. Then there was pneumonia after his ventilator was removed, fevers, blood clots in his lung, fluid around his heart, and those soaring vital signs for weeks. He lost 65 pounds.

Prayers from the saints all over the world were being prayed for Paul. Pastor Cathy prayed and claimed victory over all of it and I know the BCK'ers were praying victory-thank you!

*"Turns out, he lost no brain function."*

Our life consisted of six weeks of prayer and medical intervention and bedside vigils by his pregnant girlfriend and me. He woke up. Hallelujah! He immediately recognized us and asked Tabitha how the baby was. Wow!! Turns out he lost no brain function. He had to learn to swallow before we could give him water. He had to tolerate a thickened liquid diet before his tube feeding was discontinued. Therapists started working with him right away. His body had to resume functioning and he had to relearn to do everything.

He was discharged and his baby daughter was born on the same day!

When I took him back to the Neurosurgical Clinic a few days after discharge, he was rail thin, in a wheelchair, with a 12 inch scar down the back of his head and neck, but very happy to be alive. The doctor who came into the exam room exclaimed, "Paul, I am ecstatic to see you alive and interacting!! I was in the ER when you came in and buddy, we were not sure you'd make it."

Well, Paul worked very hard in his therapies and doing his exercises. He now walks without any assistive device. He is deaf in one ear, now, and he wears a helmet to protect the dime sized hole left in his skull in the posterior fossa, only when he plays basketball. He and Tabitha and baby Jocelyn moved to Hawaii in January, 2009, and are living on an organic farm on the big island. He picks fruit all day, traversing the uneven volcanic rock terrain. He says, "Mom, I live everyday of my life with the end result—going to heaven—in mind. I wake up every day and pray to God that I will do His will."

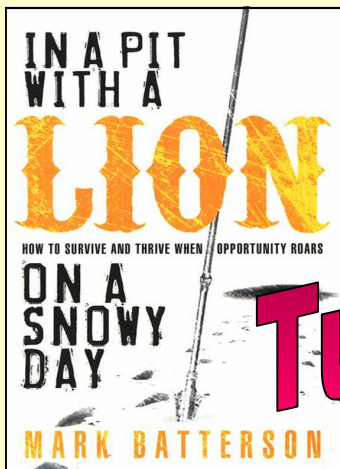

I miss you very much. I haven't found a church out here yet that is so on fire for the Lord! Yet I have found why God led me here! Thank goodness—it was kinda rough at first. I am doing some further studies in massage so that I am certified to work with a psychologist with patients who are suffering from post traumatic stress syndrome.

Pastor Brad and Cathy's teachings are a direct line to you from God! We have been blessed.

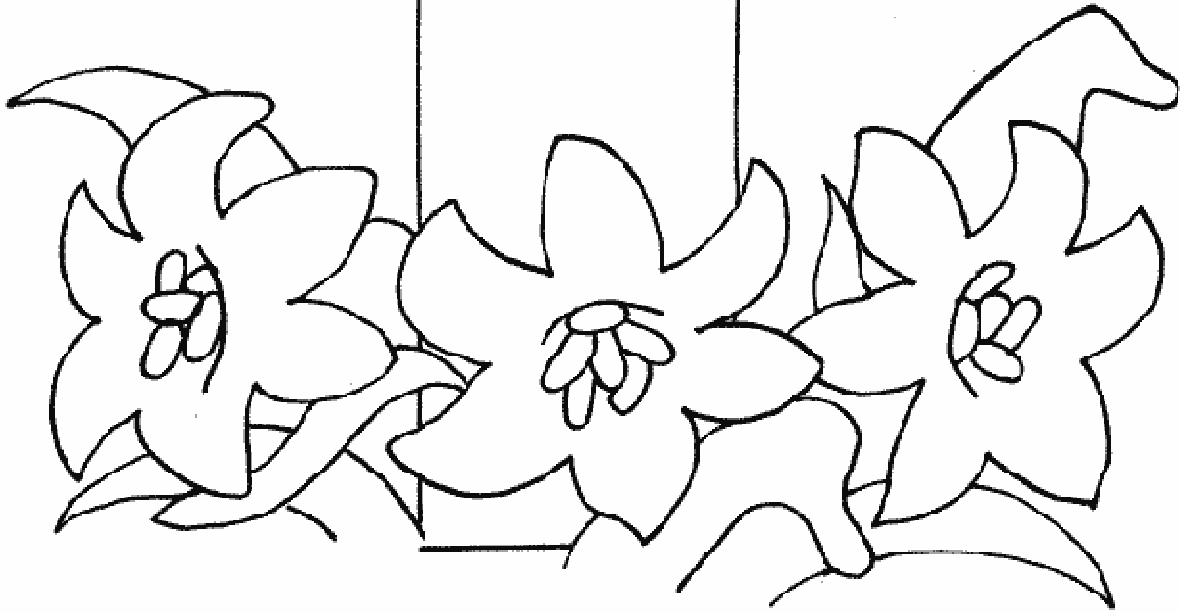
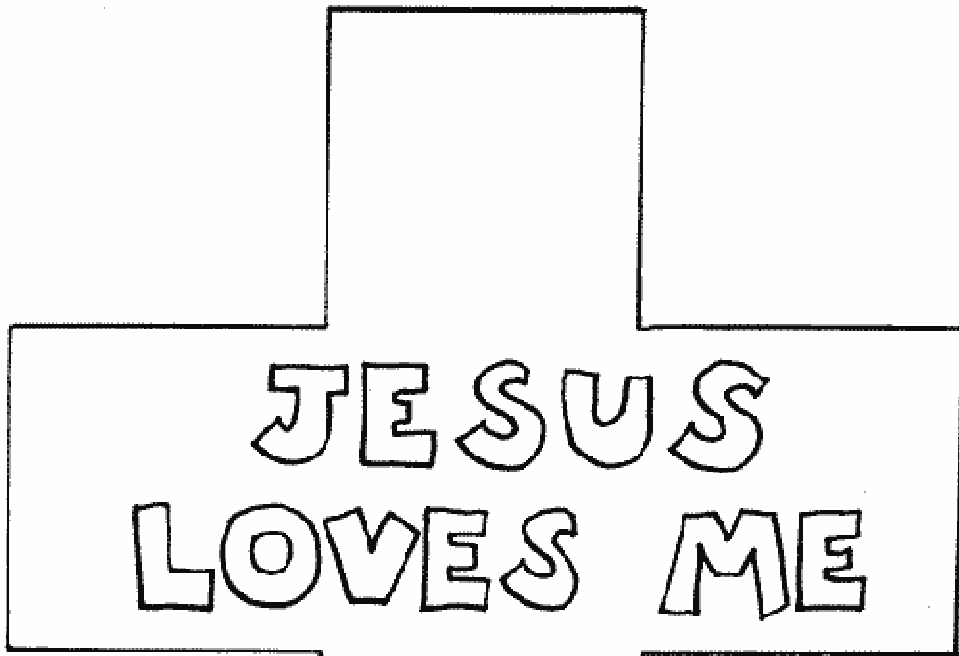

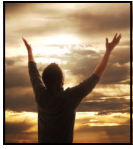

## Removing the ANTS (Automatic Negative Thoughts) from Your Mind

Medical experts report that for the average person, the vast majority of thoughts are negative. These “ANTS” (Automatic Negative Thoughts) swarm our minds and affect us physically. They increase our anxiety and stress and decrease our happiness. Additionally, psychologists report that we humans register negative thoughts, feelings, words and experiences more deeply than positive ones—a self destructive behavior referred to a “negativity bias.” Perhaps you consider yourself a positive person, but you would honestly admit to forgetting a compliment from yesterday and remembering a criticism from many years ago. We need to be aware of the ANTS (Automatic Negative Thoughts) in our heads and defeat them. The battle is underway and the warring ANTS are carrying away our happiness. I find it amazing (not in a good sense) how negative thoughts impact our minds and leave us asking, “Where did that come from?” I’m aware that positive and negative forces do exist and impact all humanity. I would attribute most ANTS to the negative forces. A simple, little explanation from a non-theologian. I’m sure someone, perhaps the wise Cherokee in the following story, can explain it better.

A Cherokee elder was telling his grandson about the battle that goes on inside our heads. “My son, the battle is between the two wolves that live inside us all. One is unhappiness (fear, worry, jealousy, sorrow, self-pity, resentment and inferiority). The other is happiness (joy, love, hope, serenity, kindness, generosity, truth and compassion). The grandson asked, “Which wolf wins?” The old Cherokee replied, “The one you feed.” Our negative thoughts feelings, words and experiences feed the “unhappiness wolf,” leaving the “happiness wolf” at risk of starvation.

Pat Robertson says it this way, “Too often, Christians allow negative thinking and self-accusation to rob them of their joy and victory.” So we need to battle the ANTS to control our thinking and starve the bad wolf to take back our joy.

Here is a personal example of how I recognized, rejected, and removed some ANTS from my own mind. Many years ago, a well-meaning man noticed my crooked, right, little finger and informed me that arthritis was caused by unresolved anger. Knowing that he had generalized and inaccurately assessed my situation, I had two unpleasant options. Number one, I could risk embarrassing him and report that arthritis didn’t cause my finger to be crooked. Number two, I could embarrass myself by revealing that my own dysfunctional, biological parents didn’t seek medical attention when their toddler’s finger was smashed and broken by a closing car door. An untreated broken bone caused my finger to be crooked. Faced with these options, I said nothing. (Today, a little wiser, a lot older, and no longer feeling responsible for my parents’ behaviors, I would probably say something.) So my mind began repeating the man’s words and convinced myself that EVERYONE saw my crooked finger and made the same assessment. I began trying to hide my “great deformity” on which I felt the word “ANGER” was tattooed. At some point, I finally wised up and stopped believing the ANTS. NEWS FLASH: NOT EVERYTHING OUR MINDS TELL US IS THE TRUTH!!! This awareness gives us the freedom to reject the negative and accept the positive thoughts with which to feed the “happiness wolf.”

Some potent, Biblical medicine for removing the ANTS from your mind can be found in Philippians 4:8, which states, “Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praise-worthy—think about such things” (NIV)

Good medicine, indeed!





## *Dancing with Him*

I was thinking about this month (April) and how important this month's celebrations are to us as Christians. I started looking through the Old Testament and reading about how the Jews celebrated this time of year. In the Hebrew calendar this is the first month of the year and they call it Nisan. It talks of this in Leviticus 23. Let me add this: In reading the Old Testament you see that it's preparing us for things fulfilled and waiting to be fulfilled in the New Testament. So with that in mind, we know that in the Old Testament when it talks about the Passover, we know in the New Testament that Jesus fulfilled that by being the perfect Passover Lamb.

"At the time of God's choosing (Deuteronomy 16:7), Jesus, who was without spot or blemish (1 Peter 1:19), became the perfect Passover lamb sacrifice; meeting all the requirements set forth by God for a Passover lamb to fulfill the blood sacrifice requirement for the remission of sin (Hebrews 9:22). His blood sacrifice was made so that when we believe and obey; accept the substitutionary shedding of blood for our sins, we might be saved from the wages of sin and death. God made a way for mankind to enjoy Him forever, establishing a new covenant with man for the remission of sin, by giving us His son (Luke 22:19-20), the perfect Passover lamb sacrifice." Digging a little deeper into the meaning of the month Nisan in the Hebrew calendar, we see that it is the month of the tribe of Judah! Judah is the fourth son of Jacob (father of the tribe of Judah), and one of the twelve tribes of Israel. His name comes from the Hebrew word of gratitude. Leah gave birth to Judah and said "Now I will praise God" (Genesis 30:35). Judah is the king (the "first") of the tribes of Israel. His name means to give thanks. Now Read Revelation 5. It talks about Jesus being the Lion of the Tribe of Judah.

To tie this all together, the color of the Tribe of Judah was green and green also means new beginnings.

\*Because of Jesus, we have a new life and a new beginning ,thanks to Jesus! We are a new creature! ("Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature." 2 Corinthians 5:17.)

\*So we ought to be praising like crazy and giving thanks always! ("But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ"! 1 Corinthians 15:57" We have no excuse but to praise God with all our might and all that we have! Praise God for who He is! Psalm 18:3 "I call to the LORD, who is worthy of praise."

*Let everything that has breath praise the LORD!*

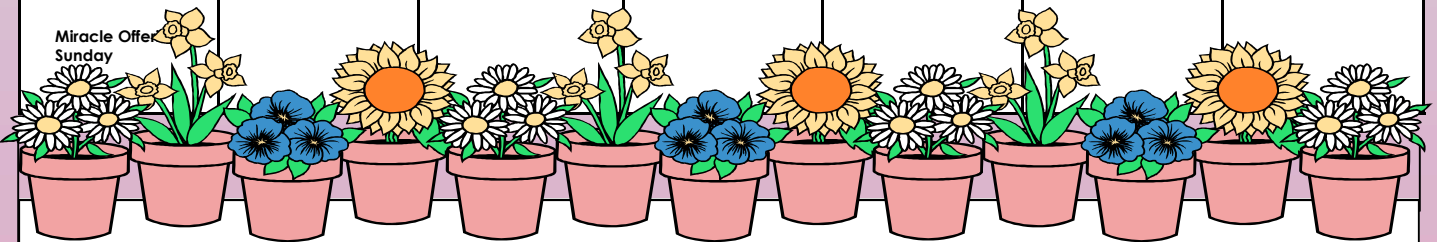
